

Wanted: people interested in joining incinerator community advisory group

But, applications being sought 'without prejudice'

CLARINGTON -- The Municipality will begin advertising soon for people to join a community advisory committee which has a slim possibility of not being necessary.

Council was asked to set the wheels in motion to find Clarington's four representatives to an incinerator Site Liaison Committee. But since the incinerator has yet to be fully approved and Clarington does not yet have an agreed-upon host community agreement with the regions of Durham and York, "I suggest it's a motion to advertise for a committee member without prejudice," Regional Councillor Mary Novak said. "We don't have a complete answer."

An advertisement with details of how to apply will appear in coming weeks, and council intends to forward a list of names to the Region in September.
